These hospitals include: Corona Regional Medical Center, Riverside Community Hospital, Parkview Hospital, RUHS – Medical Center, Loma Linda Murrieta, and Desert Regional Center – Healthy Beginnings. Loving Support Helpline staff will be coordinating all pumps. Moms can call the helpline if they will need a pump.</p>

All appointments are completed over the phone.</p>	<p>Pump Issuance: Multi-user pumps are not currently being loaned. Mothers in need are being given single-user, double electric pumps. Priority is given to mothers that are separated from their babies. Pump education occurring over the phone. WIC staff schedule an in-person pick-up date for pump. For extenuating circumstances, pumps can be mailed. Breast Pump Returns: Effective immediately, participants will hold onto previously borrowed multi-user pumps at this time; WIC is not accepting pumps back right now. Participants will hold onto pumps until centers re-open. Participants no longer breastfeeding or pumping will receive support for whatever formula she needs or wants.</p>
